

PARTICIPATION REGULATIONS
"MS&IA 2023. Modern Steels & Iron Alloys"
June 28-30, 2023, Warsaw

1. The Organizers of the **MS&IA'2023. Modern Steels & Iron Alloys** are the Faculty of Mechanical and Industrial Engineering and the Faculty Materials Science and Engineering of the Warsaw University of Technology and the Polish Foundrymen's Association (STOP).
2. The condition for participation in the conference is registration via the on-line application form available on the conference website - <https://msia2023.pl/registration/> by March 1, 2023 (early registration), by May 15, 2023 (standard registration) or by June 1, 2023 (late registration).
3. Conference registration includes a few categories of participants: Regular/Student - with conference presentation and Business delegate without a conference presentation.
4. The Participant who wants to submit an abstract has to register through the registration system and upload the abstract. Information about abstract acceptance will be sent until 7 days. After abstract acceptance, the pro form invoice will be prepared (conference fee accordant with the date of registration) and sent to the participant by e-mail.
5. The deadline for abstract submission is May 15, 2023.
6. Payments should be made by bank transfer to the STOP account by 14 days after receiving the pro forma invoice after registration or abstract acceptance but not later than June 11, 2023 (payment for late registration), without any claim for a refund in the event of the absence of the person registered for the conference.
7. Applications sent after June 1, 2023 will not be considered.
8. The condition for participation in the conference is that the full conference fee is credited to the STOP account no later by June 11, 2023.
9. Participants are required to individually book rooms directly in the Hotel and pay the appropriate fee. The conditions for booking rooms are specified by the Hotel. The Organizers are not responsible for this.

11. The participant agrees to use and processing of his image, recorded in the form of photos taken during the conference. The permit in question entitles the Organizers to process images using any technique in all fields of use (in particular: print, Internet, press publication), indefinitely and without territorial limitation - only for information and promotional purposes of the conference.
12. Conditions for resignation:
 - a. Resignation is possible only in writing, by e-mail: msia@msia2023.pl.
 - b. No written resignation from a participant by June 11, 2023, will result in charging the Participant with the total cost of participation in the conference.
 - c. Lack of full payment for participation is equal to resignation from participation in the conference.
 - d. It is allowed to change the person enlisted by June 11, 2023, after informing the Organizers.
13. The Organizers reserve the right - in the event of circumstances beyond their control, in particular the introduction of restrictions related to the COVID-19 epidemic or military conflict in Ukraine to change the conference formula to a remote or hybrid (stationary + remote).
14. If the conference is organized in a remote or hybrid form, for reasons beyond the control of the Organizers, the Participant is not entitled to reimbursement of participation fees and the right to receive compensation.
15. The Organizer reserve the right to change the conference fee in EURO in case of a change of exchange rate of more than 5%.
